Hiking tours at Zege Peninsula

Enjoy the wild coffee forests and discover the outstanding wildlife of the Lake Tana Biosphere Reserve. Choose one of the tours, as indicated on the map.

Tour 1: Wildlife Tour

Duration: 1.5h, difficulty: easy, occasionally uphill. Trail: Start at Mehal Zege Port and follow the signs to Ura Port near the lake shore. Option: Continue until Ura Kidanemihret.

Highlights: Wild coffee forest, monkeys, birds, lake shore.

Tour 2: Lake View Tour

Duration: 3 h, difficulty: moderate, uphill, occasionally thickets.

Trail: Leave the Ura Kidanemihret compound at the back and follow the signs and red marks at trees uphill to the campsite. Option: Walk back to Ura Port via Yiganda Teklehaymanot and Azewa Mariam for other churches to see.

Highlights: The campsite/viewpoint is a perfect picnic spot with lake view.

Tour 3: Bird Watching Tour

Duration: 5 h, difficulty: modarate, uphill, occasionally thickets or muddy paths.

Trail: Strat at the campsite and follow the signs to the Birdwatching spot/Temen Wuha, past the campsite (~2 hours from Ura church). Return to Bahir Dar by bus from Afaf town.

Highlights: Wild coffee forest, lake view, a perfect spot to watch crowned cranes and other birds at Yiganda Wetland.

With an extension of 1,300 hectares, Zege Peninsula offers a wonderful mix of natural and cultural attractions. Mystic Zege Peninsula attracts thousands of pilgrims each year heading for the seven monasteries from 13th century. Also for non-pilgrims, the Ura Kidanemihret and the new museum offer most impressing wall paintings and some of the oldest artifacts of the region.
